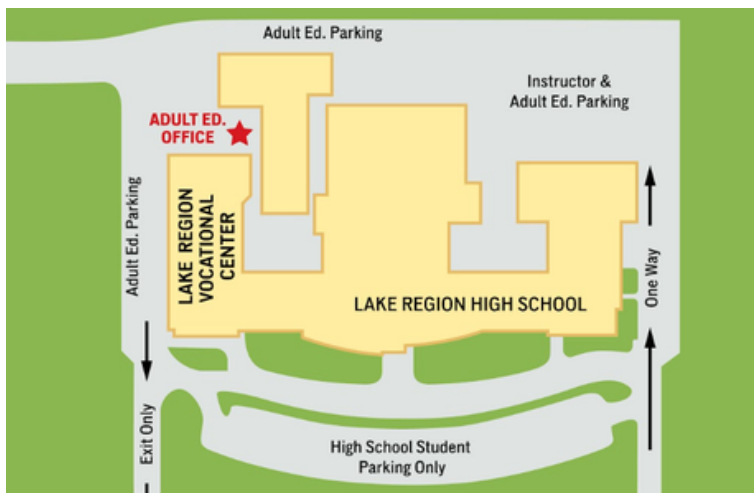

HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION

OFFERED IN NAPLES, FRYEBURG, AND ONLINE

We offer two pathways to a high school credential - the HiSET® and the adult high school diploma. Both programs are free with open enrollment and available to anyone who does not have a high school credential. Instruction is available in Naples, Fryeburg, and online.

HiSET

The HiSET® test offered through our program is your path to a High School Equivalency. Join our engaging and supportive program where we prioritize individualized academic success. With open enrollment, flexible scheduling, and personalized instruction, we tailor our approach to meet your unique needs. By successfully passing exams in Writing, Social Studies, Science, Reading, and Math, you can earn a HiSET®. Best of all, our program is provided at no cost in Maine.

ADULT DIPLOMA

We offer a high school diploma program for adults. Take classes in a variety of subjects and build your skills as you prepare for your next steps - whether that's college, a training program, or the modern workforce. At intake, our experienced academic team will review your previous high school transcript(s) to see what credits you already have and determine what classes you will need to complete in order to earn your diploma.

Math Learning Lab

Students enrolled in this course have the opportunity to learn basic, everyday math skills, prepare for the HiSET® Math exam, complete math credits for the Adult High School Diploma and/or brush up on math for college, in a relaxed, comfortable environment. Reading & Writing Learning Lab

PRE-COLLEGE MATH

Woodfords Family Services administers the Behavioral Health Professional Training & Certificate Program for the State of Maine.

BHP training and certification is required for direct care providers working in Children's Behavioral Health Services in the school, residential, or home/community setting. Additional requirements for BHP certification include current Child & Adult CPR/First Aid certification and completion of an OSHA compliant Bloodborne Pathogens training.

To be eligible to take the BHP course, individuals must be at least 18 years old and have a high school diploma or equivalent. Proof of education is required.

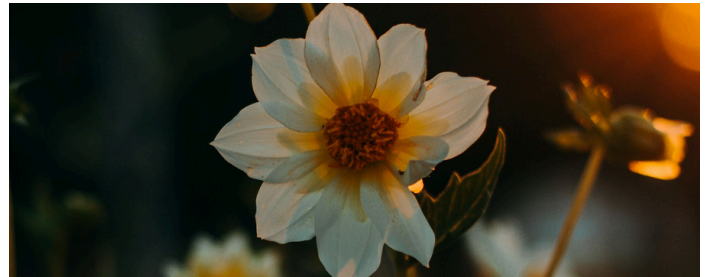
